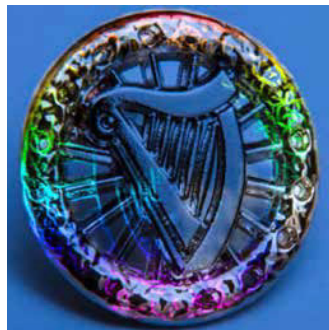

‘I actually got my nan to tell my granddad. She was like, ‘I’ll do it for you.’ ...but no, he’s absolutely fine with it’

A Look Forward

‘It’s been ingrained in everyone’s head in the Travelling community that being gay is a taboo thing... you just doesn’t exist. Obviously, it’s just been passed down from each generation to generation. And now it’s getting a bit better because...it’s more modern times now. You see it everywhere now.’
